Spanish Enrichment Classes

Our instructor Carolina is a Spanish native from Spain with years of experience teaching children Spanish in different schools around San Diego. Her program combines songs, games, puppet skits, and role-playing to ensure a highly interactive and fun language experience.

K-2nd Grade Spanish Conversation: Students will learn the basic concepts of the Spanish language while having fun. This class introduces the child to basic concepts including common greetings, colors, numbers, the alphabet, commands and short sentence structure.

3rd-5th Grade Spanish Conversation: Students will learn the basic concepts of the Spanish language including pronunciation, vocabulary, and basic grammar. It also explores some of the history and customs of the Spanish-speaking world.
